BSA used a system of letters and numbers for yearly identification of their machines. This information combined with the yearly numbers below should help you identify the year and model of your machine. The Frame Numbers are always stamped. If you find raised numbers, these are casting part numbers.

The BSA S-Series of motorcycles, most commonly known as the BSA Sloper, were a series of motorcycles produced by the Birmingham Small Arms Company (BSA) from 1927-1935.

In 1927, BSA launched their Sloper range, so called because of the sloped engine layout. By 1930, they had a range of 16 models from a 174cc to 986cc twin. As the 30s recession hit home the range was reduced and models simplified to cut costs. The power unit easily gave out capacity, and the massive flywheel smoothed pulses of capacity.
